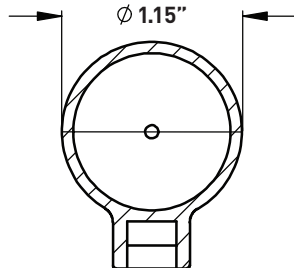


THERE ARE TWO TYPES OF CARBINE RECEIVER EXTENSIONS (BUFFER TUBES): MIL-SPEC, AND COMMERCIAL. BEFORE PROCEEDING, CONFIRM YOU HAVE THE CORRECT RECEIVER EXTENSION FOR YOUR BTR/BSL.

**INCORRECT INSTALLATION WILL RESULT IN DAMAGE TO YOUR BRACE AND/OR TUBE!

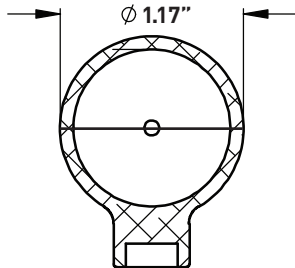
The easiest way to distinguish between mil-spec and commercial receiver extensions is to measure the tube diameter (see illustrations below). The brace should slide easily over the receiver extension. Call 1.877.4MAGPUL if you are unsure of this installation.

1. MIL-SPEC TUBE CROSS SECTION:



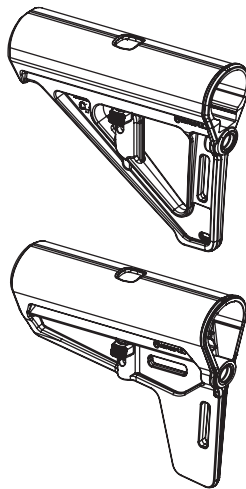
Mil-spec receiver extensions have a slightly smaller diameter of approx. 1.15", and generally have a flat back. Both the BSL and BTR will fit over this tube.

2. COMMERCIAL TUBE CROSS SECTION:



Commercial receiver extensions have a slightly larger diameter of approx. 1.17", and usually have slanted backs. Some commercial tubes may have a flat back and will still be compatible.

The BTR/BSL WILL NOT fit on this tube.
