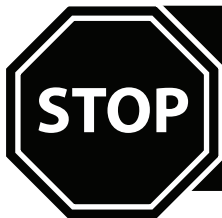

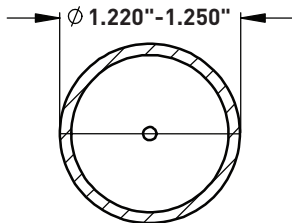
IF YOU ARE INSTALLING THE BDA ONTO A MIL-SPEC CARBINE RECEIVER EXTENSION, PLEASE PROCEED DIRECTLY TO SECTION 1 OF THE INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS. IF YOU ARE INSTALLING YOUR BDA BRACE ONTO A PISTOL RECEIVER EXTENSION, CONTINUE READING.

THE BDA BRACE ACCOMMODATES TWO SIZE RANGES OF PISTOL RECEIVER EXTENSIONS (BUFFER TUBES): 1.220" - 1.250" AND 1.175" - 1.200". BEFORE PROCEEDING, CONFIRM YOU HAVE THE A COMPATIBLE RECEIVER EXTENSION FOR YOUR BDA.

INCORRECT INSTALLATION WILL RESULT IN DAMAGE TO YOUR BRACE AND/OR TUBE!

The easiest way to determine which Clamp Set you should use is to measure the tube diameter (see illustrations below). The brace should slide easily over the receiver extension. Call 1.877.4MAGPUL if you are unsure of this installation.

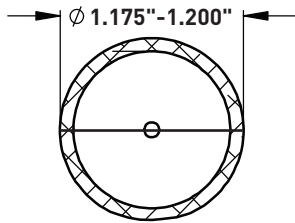
1. CLAMP SET A TUBE CROSS SECTION:



If the diameter of the Pistol Receiver Extension measures 1.220" - 1.250" select Pistol Receiver Extension Clamp Set A.

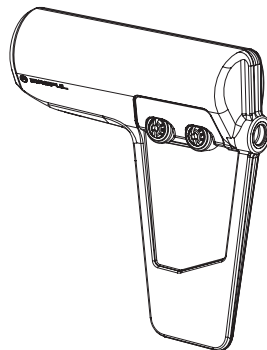
INSERT CLAMP A IMAGE AS SEEN IN INSTRUCTIONS SECTION 2, STEP 3

2. CLAMP SET B TUBE CROSS SECTION:



If the diameter of the Pistol Receiver Extension measures 1.175" - 1.200" select Pistol Receiver Extension Clamp Set B.
